Information about European Union's REACH Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC)

RoHS-Conformity acc. to EU declaration 2011/65/EU

Dear Sir or Madam,

In accordance with Article 3 of the REACH Regulation, Letronic e.K. is neither a manufacturer nor importer of chemical substances and products. Our company does not sell such products in the EU market.

Letronic e.K., as a responsible supplier, ensures that products in the entire portfolio meet REACH Regulations. No REACH substances, according to Article 7 of the REACH Regulations (EC) 1907/2006, are intended to be released under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use. Under this directive, registration of products is not required.

As a "downstream user" in the supply chain, we are in close and constant contact with our vendors and we have received confirmation that products are preregistered/registered and meet REACH registration requirements.

In acknowledgement of Information from our vendors, we could confirm to the best of our knowledge, that all our products do not contain any prohibited substances of the latest SVHC-list above the maximum percentage.

We would like to however point out that our company, Letronic e.K., itself does not conduct any Test nor Analysis to determine the presence of SVHC candidate substances. Should there be changes in the Candidate List of substances, of which our products will be affected accordingly, we will comply with our duty to notify you immediately.

Furthermore, we confirm based on the current state of knowledge, that our cables and lines do not contain any SVHC substances on the ECHA list.

We assure you that all our products are RoHS compliant according to declaration 2011/65/EU - including the delegated directive 2015/863 - of the European Parliament and of the council.
